MOTION


The proponents of an affordable housing initiative petition are in the process of gathering signatures to be filed with the City Clerk's Office the week of May 9, 2016. As such, the City Clerk will need to conduct a random verification of the signatures for this petition.

The costs for the random verification are not funded in the Department's budget; however, savings exist in the Department's Salaries General account to help pay for these costs. Also, the Department has a need to pay for additional unfunded costs in its expense accounts that can also be absorbed from the surplus in the Salaries General account.

It is important to note that after this random verification process, if the results are inconclusive, a full review of the signatures may require an additional \$245,000. That potential cost is not needed at this time.


I THEREFORE MOVE that \$185,000 within the City Clerk Fund No. 100-14 be transferred from Account No. 001010 (Salaries – General) as follows: \$105,000 to Account No. 001070 (Salaries – As Needed) and \$80,000 to Account No. 006010 (Office and Administrative Expense) to cover the cost of a random verification of the signatures for an affordable housing initiative petition which will be filed with the City Clerk's Office the week of May 9, 2016.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications as necessary to the above fund transfer instructions to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
