On September 2, 2016, item no. 2 [CF 16-0600-S157] was placed on an agenda in a section "Items for which Public Hearings Have Been Held" for ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION re: amending certain sections of the LA Municipal Code [LAMC].

The ostensible purpose of the ordinance was to divert, Council approved proceeds from the sale of City surplus properties during the fiscal year 2016-2017, which would otherwise be deposited 50 percent into the Council District Real Property Trust Fund in which property was located and 50 percent into the general fund, to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

On September 9, 2016, item no. 3 [CF 16-0600-S157] was placed on an City Council Agenda in a section "Items for which Public Hearings Have Been Held" for ORDINANCE SECOND CONSIDERATION

Eric Preven, a member of the public, put in a speaker card on September 2, 2016 and then again on September 9, 2016. Therefore, because the City Council and City Attorney and Councilmembers Borin, Kuekamin and City Clerk Holly Wolcott and Alietti, and the Sergeant-at-Arms were fully aware of the request to be heard, and because the Council president refused to take comment before or during consideration of the item, the Brown Act has been violated. Cease and Desist denying comments Cue and Correct this violation by placing the matter on a noticed agenda for Council.
