Summary:

On June 8, 2016, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered the June 1, 2016 LAHSA report in response to the budget motion instructing LAHSA to report on the breakdown of how the Fiscal Year 2016-17 funding will be allocated, including a breakdown of programming versus administrative costs.

Representatives from the Los Angeles Homeless Services Agency, City Administrative Office, and Chief Legislative Analyst Office provided some background on the matter and responded to questions from the committee members. The matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
