## OUR IMPACT

### COMMUNITY ADULT CENTERS – AGING IN PLACE

VIC oversees the operation and management of four multi-purpose community centers for mature adults in Sherman Oaks, Van Nuys, Pacoima, and Northridge. The Centers, funded by the City Department of Aging, are attractive, safe places that provide social, educational, fitness, and recreational opportunities to active seniors in the San Fernando Valley.

- ◆ 1,000-1,700 seniors are served by four **Multi-Purpose Senior Centers** daily.
- ◆ **42,000** rides are provided to eligible seniors per year by the **Transportation Services**.
- ◆ **975** seniors receive benefits of **Evidenced Based Programs** annually.
- ◆ **430** seniors receive **Care Management** annually.

### NUTRITION MEAL SERVICES – HEALTHY SUSTENANCE

VIC provides nutritionally balanced meals to mature adults, families, and individuals throughout the San Fernando Valley.

- ◆ **390,000** meals served annually
- ◆ Home Delivered Meals: 60+ years of age
- ◆ Meal Sites: 60+ years of age
- ◆ Meals On Wheels: No age requirement
- ◆ Santa Clarita Community Based Service (Adult Day Health Care Center)

### EMERGENCY SUPPORT SERVICES – BASIC NEEDS

- ◆ VIC oversees the operation and management with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Emergency food and shelter funds are distributed to persons in need in partnership with the Interfaith Food Pantry Coalition.
- ◆ **400,000** individuals, families, women, and children receive emergency food and meals from the **VIC Interfaith Food Pantry Coalition** every year.
- ◆ **2,892** people received family social services, information, and referral by way of the **Interfaith Food Assistance Program** and **North Hollywood Interfaith Pantry**.
