RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

DISCUSSION

The LAPD is seeking approval to reprogram funds totaling \$133,735 within the 2015 DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction Program Grant. The US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs has approved funds to be reprogrammed from Personnel and Equipment Costs to Travel, Contractual Services, and Other Costs. The reprogramming of funds will allow LAPD to pay for specialized onsite training and online validation support, and various software and licenses to allow more analysts to utilize the tools and equipment at the Forensic Science Division's laboratories.
