El Grito de Dolores marks the beginning of the Mexican War of Independence and is celebrated September 15th of each year. For more than thirty years, the celebration of El Grito has been sponsored by the Comite Civico-Patriotico, Mexican Consulate and the City of Los Angeles. This annual celebration on City Hall Spring Street steps entertains residents with a family event that will feature music, special guest(s), and a reenactment of the historic cry and bell ringing (the "official portion"). The Seventh Council District is preparing for a large scale event to continue in this tradition.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of General Services be authorized to accept donations to cover the cost of El Grito and to deposit any such individual donations not exceeding \$5,000 each into the General Services Trust Fund 843/40, Account 40280R. Any individual donation exceeding \$5,000 shall be submitted to the Council for Acceptance.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$69,216.39 be transferred from the General Services Trust Fund 843/40, Account 40280K to the General Services Trust Fund 843/40 Account 40280R.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of General Services be allowed to make corrections, clarifications, and technical adjustments as needed to implement this motion and the Council's intent.
