We, Robin Greenberg and Nickie Miner, declare that we are the President and Vice President respectively of the Bel Air Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council (BABCNC), and that on September 28, 2016, a Brown-Act noticed public meeting was held by the BABCNC, with a quorum of 16 board members present and that by a vote of 16 yes, 0 no, and 0 abstentions, the Bel Air Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council voted unanimously to support the motion put forth by CD-5 CM Paul Koretz, seconded by CD-4 David Ryu, on June 24, 2016 (CF 16-0757) that Planning, Office of City Attorney, Building & Safety, Bureau of Street Services, DOT and other relevant departments report back on establishing a community and environmental impact review process for the development of Single Family Home Construction over 20,000 square feet; receive input from surrounding neighbors, Community Associations, and Neighborhood Councils, and that Building & Safety and the Office of the City Attorney establish additional citations for construction violations and commercial use of properties located in the single family zone above 20,000 square feet based on a percentage of the value of assessed property to deter such properties from being nuisances to the surrounding neighborhood.
