Re: FY 2016 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Budget Modification and Grant Contracting Authorities (Council File No. 16-0777)

Dear Honorable Members:

Transmitted herewith for City Council consideration are proposed budget modifications and contracting authorities related to the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Fiscal Year 2016 Urban Areas Security Initiative (FY16 UASI) grant award. On March 21, 2017, the City Council accepted the FY16 UASI grant in the amount of \$54,888,000 with a grant performance period from September 1, 2016 to May 31, 2019 (Council File No. 16-0777).

Cost Savings

As subrecipients completed their FY16 UASI grant projects, cost savings totaling \$48,439 were identified from various approved equipment, exercise, and training projects from the following: the City of Compton Fire Department returned their UASI 16 allocation of \$18,940 in full, City of Glendale Fire Department (\$8,374) and City of Beverly Hills Fire Department (\$21,125) (herein after referred to as, "Partner Jurisdictions").

Additionally, the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) has identified cost savings totaling \$94,000 from Urban Search and Rescue (\$13,500) and Tactical Emergency Medical Services (\$80,500) training projects.

In order to fully expend the funds within the grant performance period, funds were reallocated the LAFD approved equipment projects as follows: Tactical Emergency



Medical Services (\$62,939), Hazardous Material (\$20,000), Urban Search and Rescue (\$18,500), Community Emergency Response Team (\$15,837), and Maritime Response (\$25,163). This modification is pending grantor approval.

Authority is being requested to modify the FY16 UASI grant budget, conduct the necessary transfer of appropriations, and amend the subrecipient agreements, as indicated above.

Recommendations

It is therefore requested that the City Council:

1. **Authorize** the Mayor, or designee, to:
 - a. Modify the existing grant budget (Council File No. 16-0777) for the FY16 UASI grant by reallocating funds between projects as described within this report;
 - b. Terminate the contract with the City of Compton, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form;
 - c. Negotiate and execute a contract amendment with the City of Glendale to decrease their total contract amount by \$8,374, from the previous authorized amount of \$2,676,878, to a new contract amount of \$2,668,504, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form; and
 - d. Negotiate and execute a contract amendment with the City of Beverly Hills to decrease their total contract amount by \$21,125, from the previous authorized amount of \$157,400, to a new contract amount of \$136,275, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
2. **Authorize** the Controller to:
 - a. **Transfer** appropriations and create new appropriation accounts within Fund 59E, FY16 UASI, as follows:

3. **Authorize** the Controller to decrease the LAFD's Fund 100/001098 Account by \$94,000.00;
4. **Authorize** the Controller to transfer cash from Fund 59E/46 to reimburse the General Fund, on an as-needed basis, upon presentation of proper documentation City Departments, subject to the approval of the Mayor's Office of Public Safety; and
5. **Authorize** the Mayor, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
