## **MOTION**

The City Attorney's Office, in consultation with LA Sanitation (LASAN), is requesting authority to retain outside counsel (Downey Brand LLP) for legal services relating to Los Angeles Waterkeeper v. Water Boards, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BS163391. This litigation deals with the water-effect ratio for copper and lead in the LA River granted to LASAN by the State.

The above-referenced litigation is related to the 2012 Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit where the litigation costs would normally be paid from the Stormwater Pollution Abatement Fund (SPAF). However, the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget for the SPAF does not contain sufficient revenue nor appropriations to fund this work and existing funded programs cannot be deferred without incurring liability risk.

LA Sanitation proposes a loan in an amount up to \$100,000 to SPAF from another of its special funds, the Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund (SCMF), to be repaid with interest.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Controller to transfer cash in an amount up to \$100,000 and create an appropriation as follows:
