
ORDINANCE NO. 184656

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Nos. 115,573 and 123,519 amending Ordinance No. 65,419 establishing a building line.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section _. Ordinance Nos. 115,573 and 123,519 amending Ordinance No. 65,419; entitled . An Ordinance ordering the establishment of a building line on both sides of MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD (formerly, Santa Barbara Avenue) between Figueroa Street and Vermont Avenue . . . was passed by the Council of the City of Los Angeles at its meeting of November 21, 1929, . . . is hereby amended by <u>repealing</u> the provisions establishing the building line on that portion of MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD (formerly, Santa Barbara Avenue), as depicted on the following diagram:

Section . The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
