SUMMARY

At its meeting held September 7, 2016, the Housing Committee considered the Mayor's appointment of Mr. Daniel Tenenbaum to the HACLA Board of Commissioners. The nominee discussed his professional experience managing apartment rental properties, and his non-profit work as an advocate for affordable housing and homeless services. The Committee recommended that Council approve the Mayor's nomination of Mr. Tenenbaum to HACLA.
