As you are well aware, there is deep concern for that justice and care be served here. I urge you to consider the importance that such properties and the rights of the elderly resident be served here, and validate the public opposition by upholding the appeal.

Furthermore, please direct city planning to create a protocol for identifying the cumulative impact of each project on the loss of RSO units.

It is my understanding that the developer, Urban Blox, has never built a single project for which it has sought entitlements. The city, in good conscience, must refuse to be party to the displacement of its residents.
