I live in the neighborhood, and I strongly oppose this project. Just last week it took me 65 minutes to travel from Sunset and Kenter to the 405. The additional burden on our community will be too much. We cannot handle any more projects, building, trucks, hazards, and backup on our town. And to top it all off, we were not informed of this project and even if we had known, the address was false. PLEASE listen to us, and do not approve this project. The unsafe nature of this project, the near accidents that we encounter every day on this road and the traffic impact of this project are serious issues that residents of this area understand very well.
