TO CITY CLERK FOR PLACEMENT ON NEXT  
REGULAR COUNCIL AGENDA TO BE POSTED #53

The City of Los Angeles is working toward increasing opportunities for Minority Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Disabled Business Enterprises, and Small Business Enterprises. Council File 16-1235 (Martinez – Cedillo – Harris-Dawson – Huizar – Price) seeks to increase participation in the Zero Waste LA Franchise System pending before Council. The current participation rate is shamefully low and unacceptable.

It is essential that the City take significant steps, to the best of its ability, to maximize subcontracting opportunities for businesses not generally represented in the waste and recycling industry and require that franchise haulers do better.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Attorney prepare and present an ordinance to amend Section 66.33 through 66.33.10 of Article 6, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to require each Franchisee to demonstrate on a quarterly basis throughout the term of its franchise, to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Sanitation, the Franchisee's best efforts to identify additional subcontracting opportunities to increase participation by subcontractors.

I FUTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Sanitation shall develop Rules and Regulations as to how to determine and measure the best efforts and assign monetary penalties for failure to demonstrate best efforts. These Rules and Regulations shall be presented for approval to the Board of Public Works.

I FURTHER MOVE that penalties collected be deposited into a special fund controlled by the City for additional subcontract outreach efforts to increase participation in the waste and recycling industry.
