

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 291 (Chiu), the Immigrant Tenant Protection Act of 2017, which would establish numerous legal protections against disclosure of tenants' immigration or citizenship status to federal immigration authorities.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Huizar - Krekorian), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 291 (Chiu), the Immigrant Tenant Protection Act of 2017, which would establish numerous legal protections against the disclosure of tenants' immigration or citizenship status to federal immigration authorities, namely prohibiting a landlord from threatening to disclose the immigration status of a tenant for the purpose of influencing a tenant to vacate a dwelling.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on August 29, 2017, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Huizar - Krekorian) and a report from the CLA relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 291 (Chiu), which would establish numerous legal protections against disclosure of tenants' immigration or citizenship status to federal immigration authorities. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information a summary of the Resolution.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
