The undersigned organizations write to express our full support for your Resolution #17-0002-S97 for the City of Los Angeles to support Senate Bill 100 (De León), which seeks to achieve 100 percent renewable electricity in California by 2045.

Burning oil, gas and coal is not only polluting our air, water and land, it's changing our climate even faster than scientists predicted. The good news is that we can we can have strong local economies and healthier communities now, and a livable future for kids growing up today if we take action now to move rapidly to a 100 percent renewable energy future.

The City of Los Angeles, through a motion by Councilmember Mike Bonin and under Mayor Eric Garcetti's leadership, has pledged to align with the nations who adopted the Paris Climate Accord and increase investment in renewable energy.
