

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to requiring businesses spending money in local elections to certify the businesses are not influenced by foreign entities.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin - Huizar):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the assistance of the City Ethics Commission, to report to Council on options of pursuing an ordinance to require any businesses spending money in local elections to certify that they are not influenced by foreign entities.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on April 10, 2019 the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Motion (Bonin - Huizar) relative to requiring businesses spending money in local elections to certify the businesses are not influenced by foreign entities.
