

Subject: **STANDARD OFFER FOR DWP OUTDOOR LIGHTING PROGRAM SERVICE AGREEMENT AND RATE CALCULATION METHODOLOGY**

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### RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

1. Approve the proposed resolution to authorize the Department of Water and Power to utilize a Standard Offer for DWP Outdoor Lighting Program Service Agreement and Rate Calculation Methodology pursuant to Charter Section 373; and,
2. Return the proposed resolution to the Department for further processing, including City Council consideration.

### SUMMARY

Approval of the proposed resolution will establish a customer agreement referred to as the Standard Offer for DWP Outdoor Lighting Program Service (Agreement) and rate methodology for DWP's outdoor lighting service (OL). The service provides unmetered energy for outdoor lighting mounted on existing DWP power poles, on City of Los Angeles streetlight poles, or on poles owned by customers. The proposed new Agreement and rate methodology enables DWP to enter 20-year agreements for OL service and to establish rates to fully recover program costs.

Existing OL customers will be able to continue on a month-to-month basis utilizing the current rate methodology and terms until an OL lighting fixture type at a particular premises is changed. DWP anticipates these changes to fixture types will occur during regular maintenance or as the Department replaces fixtures with energy-efficient light emitting diode (LED) fixtures.

City Council approval is required pursuant to Charter Section 373. In accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5, unless the Council takes action disapproving the proposed Agreement within 60 days after submission to the City Council, the Agreement will be deemed approved. The City Attorney has approved the proposed resolution as to form and legality.

## FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed resolution is not anticipated to impact the DWP Power Revenue Fund or the DWP Water Revenue Fund. There is no fiscal impact to the City General Fund. The proposed Agreement complies with the Department's Financial Policies.
