

## **REQUEST FOR REPORT**

On June 7, 2017, the Energy and Environment (EE) Committee considered a report from City Administrative Officer relative to the Solid Waste Integrated Resources Plan (SWIRP) as the City's long-term plan to achieve zero waste by 2025, commonly known as the Zero Waste Plan.

During the discussion, the EE Committee continued the matter and instructed the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst as may be necessary, to report back on:

- An update to the SWIRP from the previous version from October 2013.
- The development of a definition of "environmental justice," along with set of proposed policies and criteria that can be adopted to ensure environmental justice is a formalized principle of the City.
- Incorporation of the definition, policies, and criteria into the SWIRP.
- Ways to strengthen the SWIRP Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to capture the environmental justice definitions and principles into the SWIRP itself, as well as the program EIR that needs to be adopted.
