## ITEM #1 – Council File No. 17-0071-S1

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. REQUEST the City Attorney's office to prepare a new draft ordinance for consideration by the Ad Hoc Committee on Police Reform on Tuesday April 2, 2019 with the following amendments and changes to the draft ordinance on file dated February 5, 2019:
  - a. ADD a new section to LAMC Sec. 22.290 to require an annual audit by the Inspector General of the Police Commission on the Board of Rights proceedings.
  - b. ADD a new section to LAMC Sec. 22.290 to require the release of Board of Rights decisions to the public as allowable under current law.
- 2. ADOPT the Recommendations of the Police Commission report dated Dec. 6, 2018 with the following amendments and REQUEST the Police Commission to concur in these changes:
  - a. Clarify that Recommendation 2(a) only applies to felony and serious misdemeanor convictions as defined by the Police Commission.
  - b. Clarify Recommendation 2(c) to a length of three years.
  - c. Clarify Recommendation 2(e) to a length of two years.
  - d. Require the Police Commission to expand and maintain up-to-date training programs for the civilian panel members and provide all training materials on the Commission's website
  - e. Require the Police Commission to conduct aggressive outreach throughout the City of Los Angeles prior to opening any application window for a civilian panel member.
  - f. Include a qualification preference that the final selection of civilian panel members include a minimum of one member per Council District as new members are selected and approved.
- 3. ADOPT the Recommendations of the City Attorney report dated March 14, 2019 and INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer to provide for funding and a transition plan in the upcoming FY 2019-20 Mayor's Budget Proposal.
