AD HOC COMMITTEE ON IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding the Mobilizing Against Sanctuary Cities Act.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Krekorian - Cedillo), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying revised RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-2018 Federal Legislative Program, OPPOSITION to H.R. 83, the Mobilizing Against Sanctuary Cities Act, and any other similar legislation, which would prohibit any state or local government in violation of Section 642 of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigration Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1373) from receiving any federal funds.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Ad Hoc Committee on Immigrant Affairs dated March 29, 2017, the CLA recommends that Council oppose H.R. 83, the Mobilizing Against Sanctuary Cities Act, and any other similar legislation, as recommended by Resolution (Krekorian - Cedillo). The CLA states that any cuts to federal funding received by the City could severely impact services, infrastructure, and capital improvement projects, as well as the safety of the City's residents.

According to the CLA, H.R. 83 directs the United States Attorney General to compile and issue an annual report concerning compliance of states and cities, and that any jurisdiction that is found to be out of compliance would be ineligible for federal financial assistance for a minimum of one year. As of January 23, 2017, the Bill is pending in Committee.

At its special meeting held March 30, 2017, the Ad Hoc Committee on Immigrant Affairs recommended that Council approve the CLA's recommendation.
