

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the status of the Proposition HHH Permanent bond funds and the City's strategy for achieving 10,000 supportive housing units.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Ryu for Krekorian):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department, with assistance from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report within 30 days on the status of Proposition HHH bond funds and the City's strategy for achieving its 10,000 unit goal; the report should include a status on all projects in the Proposition HHH pipeline, number of units anticipated to be developed with Proposition HHH funds, per unit cost, timeline for project construction completion, and any forthcoming new strategies to meet the City's supportive housing unit goal.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 6, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (O'Farrell - Ryu for Krekorian) relative to the status of the Proposition HHH Permanent bond funds and the City's strategy for achieving its 10,000 unit goal.
