Subject: Renaming of Community area as Glencrest Hills - CF 17-0102

The Bureau of Engineering has reviewed the application submitted to change the community name of a neighborhood in the North Valley. The application proposes renaming the neighborhood as Glencrest Hills.

There are approximately 1,166 parcels with an estimated 5,388 people population derived from the 2010 census. The proposed addition is almost entirely within Council District 2, with a relatively small portion falling in Council District 7. The proposed addition lies entirely within the Community Plan Area of Sun Valley - La Tuna Canyon, and the Sun Valley Neighborhood Council. The proposed addition resides in the 91352 and 91504 zip codes.

The attached maps shows the parcels within the proposed new community borders as shown on the application in relation to the boundaries of the Council Districts, Community Plan Areas, Neighborhood Councils, Census Tracts, and zip codes.

The Bureau of Engineering has no additional pertinent information concerning the historical use for this neighborhood in the community.
