NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, in accordance with §1245.235 of the California Code of Civil Procedure (CCP), the public hearing will be held by the Los Angeles City Council **on Tuesday, September 18, 2018, at 10:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter in the John Ferraro Council Chamber, Room 340, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, to consider reports from the City Attorney and the Board of Airport Commissioners and to consider adopting an Ordinance authorizing a Resolution of Necessity to acquire by eminent domain portions of property located at 9790 Bellanca Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90045 and bearing Assessor's Parcel Numbers 4125-026-014 and 4125-026015 (Property).

Acquisition of the Property by eminent domain is necessary to implement the projects under the Landside Access Modernization Program, a public project designed to improve and modernize access at Los Angeles International Airport.

In this regard, section 1245.235(b)(3) provides that "failure to file a written request to appear and be heard within fifteen (15) days after the Notice was mailed will result in waiver of the right to appear and be heard" on the matters and issues that are the subject of the hearing. However, for purposes of this hearing, the City will waive the requirement that a written request be submitted to appear and be heard.
