PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2016-18 National Crime Statistics Exchange Implementation Assistance Program and First Amendment to Contract with Justice and Security Strategies, Inc.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department, or designee to:

- a. Accept the no-cost grant extension for the 2016-18 National Crime Statistics Exchange Implementation Assistance Program from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Statistics, extending the period of the grant award from September 30, 2018 through September 30, 2019.
- b. Negotiate and execute the First Amendment to Contract No. C-130065 between the City of Los Angeles and Justice and Security Strategies, Inc., extending the term of the agreement from September 30, 2018 through September 30, 2019, subject to the review and approval of the City Attorney as to form.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that the approval will extend the grant award period for the 2016-18 National Crime Statistics Exchange Implementation Assistance Program from September 30, 2018 through September 30, 2019 at no-cost. There is no impact to the General Fund as a result these recommendations. Acceptance of the grant is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time revenue is used for one-time expenses. No matching funds are required for this grant.
