

Draft Instructions -- Item 2

Instruct the Planning Department, with the assistance of other departments and outside experts as needed, report on the City's current practices to protect public health from air pollution from freeways, including the Freeway Adjacent Advisory Notice, air filtration requirements and any other conditions imposed on development near freeways.

The report should identify baseline/existing conditions citywide so as to allow the council to determine the extent to which potential new requirements should be considered.

The report should recommend updates or improvements to current requirements, which could minimize exposure to air pollution. Among the other other strategies that the report should consider are the education of participants in Community Plan updates and facilitating the deployment of air quality monitoring.

The report should also report on the status of City programs to foster a transition to electric vehicles, with recommendations to expedite this transition and to encourage its benefits are shared by lower-income and high-pollution neighborhoods.
