Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Huizar):

- 1. INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), and the Los Angeles Police Department to report in 30 days on the status and implementation of the HOPE teams
- 2. INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works, BOS, and the Personnel Department to report on staffing for the HOPE team and the CSI, including streamlining and expedited filling of vacant positions.
