MOTION

The Tom Bradley Youth and Family Center is in need of rehabilitation and other construction activities.

The Bureau of Engineering is well suited to monitor any proposed contract for the completion of the rehabilitation and construction work at the Tom Bradley Youth and Family Center.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD 10 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Council District 10 Community Benefits Trust Fund for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$257,597 in the Council District 10 Public Benefits Trust Fund No. 50R-14 be transferred / appropriated to a new account in the Engineering Services Trust Fund No. 682-50, entitled "Tom Bradley Center Construction Grant" for the rehabilitation/ construction activities required at the Tom Bradley Youth and Family Center in Council District Ten.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Engineer be instructed and authorized to negotiate and execute the necessary agreement or other documents with any entity, agency or organization, in the above amount and for the above purpose, if needed, andf subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or needed new instructions, to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
