Summary:

At a regular meeting held on April 17, 2018, the PLUM Committee considered a report from the LADBS in response to Motion (Huizar - Martinez). Staff from the LADBS provided the Committee with an overview of the report. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to concur with the LADBS recommendations, which includes: subject lots be flagged to alert permit issuance staff; ensure construction documents for non-residential projects incorporate the appropriate good housekeeping management practices; flag construction and demolition activities within 1.7 miles of the Exide Technologies Facility to provide applicants with additional information; and coordinate with the Department of City Planning to flag all subject lots of concern on the Zone Information and Map Access System. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
