PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Livability and Environment Quality Program that includes illegal dumping and homelessness encampment clean-ups, metrics used to measure the success of the Homeless Outreach and Proactive Engagement (HOPE) Teams, and the backlog of Clean Streets LA encampment service requests.

Recommendation for Council action:

CONCUR with the recommendations of the Homelessness and Poverty and Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committees, as amended to include the following recommendation:

INSTRUCT and REQUEST as appropriate, the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and BOS to:

- a. Develop uniform collection, reporting, and presentation structure for HOPE Team data from the various reporting agencies.
- b. Prepare specific and consistent criteria for what a HOPE Team is and how it is deployed.
- c. Create a plan and cost for implementing a full-time HOPE Team in every LAPD division.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the BOS. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on March 28, 2018, your Public Safety Committee considered a BOS report relative to the Bureau's Livability and Environmental Quality Program - illegal dumping and homelessness encampment clean-ups and the recommendations of the Homelessness and Poverty and Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice and Committees. After an opportunity for public comment, the Public Safety Committee moved to concur with the recommendations of the Homelessness and Poverty and Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice and Committees, as amended, as detailed above.
