## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section F of Section 19.01 of Article 8, Chapter 1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended in its entirety to read as follows:
