

**ORDINANCE NO. 185269**

An ordinance amending Section 23.144 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to reassign administrative support for the Office of Public Accountability (OPA) to the Office of the City Clerk.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection (c)(2) of Section 23.144 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

(2) The Office of the City Clerk shall provide the OPA with ongoing support and advice on administrative matters, including, but not limited to, personnel, payroll, administrative, budgetary and other general matters.


Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.



the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; 3) one copy


on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of
