As requested by City Council, this Office previously prepared and transmitted for your consideration three draft ordinances adding: Article 4 to Chapter X of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to regulate commercial cannabis activities in the City; rules and regulations to support the City's implementation and administration of the new Commercial Cannabis licensing ordinance; and Article 5 to Chapter X of the LAMC to limit the location and permissibility of specified cannabis activities in the City of Los Angeles.
