ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance of the City of Los Angeles changing the name of Rodeo Road from Gramercy Place to approximately 250 feet westerly of Jefferson Boulevard and establishing the same as Obama Boulevard.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Los Angeles finds that the public interest, convenience and necessity require that the name of that certain public street, 100 feet, 80 feet, 60 feet and variable in width, being the first Westerly/Easterly trending public street southerly of Sunlight Place and Exposition Place, lying between Gramercy Place and approximately 250 feet westerly of Jefferson Boulevard, or any portion of which may be or may have been named or known as or called Rodeo Road be and the same is hereby changed to and established as Obama Boulevard.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 252 of the Charter of the City of Los Angeles, this Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
