Dear Los Angeles City Council:

I strongly **oppose** to the street name change of Rodeo Road to Obama Boulevard.

Firstly, I have lived on this street for nearly 50 years and my neighbors similarly have lived here for decades. The name change would adversely affect us and for many elderly people who would have a difficult time going through the hurdles of changing our address on many important documents such as:

CA Driver's license /ID Bank accounts Credit card companies Utility companies Social security/IRS Life, Health, and Home Insurance Companies

Also, have you seen the ridiculously long wait time at the DMV to renew a license or ID? This would be burdensome to the elderly and to the full-time working residents of Rodeo Road. We could not be compensated enough for the hours spent at the DMV.
