I want to thank Councilmember Cedillo for submitting Item 17-0728, a motion to develop an updated Traffic Plan for Dodger Stadium.

It has become critical that an updated Traffic Plan be adopted to conform with current traffic.

The traffic flow to, and from, Dodger Stadium must be directed to remain on the freeway or onto streets that are designated for such traffic

and away from residential streets. This problem has been exacerbated by online traffic applications such as Waze and Google Maps.

My name is Roger Herman and I have lived in Solano Canyon for 32 Years.

The problems with traffic , Fireworks, fans invading our streets with trash ,noise, parking, drinking and urination have increased since

the new Management of the Guggenheim group.I live on academy rd. Between Jarvis and Bouett. Before games the traffic is so bad that we

cannot leave or get to our houses. Academy is a very narrow street with cars parked on both sides. It leaves only one lane.

The 110 freeway leads the dodger traffic down that one lane. It is unacceptable . There is one solution to use the stadium way entry only

and/or close the park's Dodger entry at the academy gate
