AGREEMENT

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

- Approve the proposed resolution by Ordinance pursuant to Charter Sections 373 and 674 to: (i) authorize the approval of amendments to the Navajo Project Agreements and Facilities Agreement, and (ii) delegate authority to the DWP Board of Commissioners for future amendments to the agreements that do not increase costs or extend the term; and,
- 2. Return the proposed resolution to the Department for further processing, including Council consideration.

SUMMARY

Approval of the proposed resolution will authorize the DWP to amend a package of agreements relating to the transfer of ownership for the Navajo Project. These proposed amendments affect existing joint project agreements by updating the current status and configurations as well as the responsibilities of the participants. Specifically, approval will authorize the following:

Furthermore, the proposed resolution requests the adoption and ratification by Ordinance of STS Operating Agreement Amendments 1 through 5 to provide administrative updates. The amendments affect various facilities updates and costs including the calculation of load dispatching allocation, participant cost responsibilities, new configurations and connections to transmission lines, and the construction of a new substation. These prior amendments were approved by the DWP Board of Commissioners (Board) and require City Council adoption and ratification pursuant to Charter Section 674.

Finally, DWP is requesting that Council delegate authority to the DWP Board for future amendments to these agreements provided that those future amendments do not increase costs or extend the term of the agreements.

The City Attorney has approved the proposed resolution as to form and legality.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed resolution will impact the DWP Power Revenue Fund. There is no fiscal impact to the City General Fund.
