


MOTION



I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations relative to the matter of the Citywide Exclusive Franchise System for Solid Waste and Handling and Zero Waste LA/Franchise System (RecycLA); CF 17-0878-S7 and Item No. 30 on today's Council agenda:

- **DISAPPROVE**, without prejudice, the Board of Public Works' (Board) October 29, 2018 action relative to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Addendum No. 2 to 2014 Certified Program Environmental Impact Report for the RecycLA Program and Facility Certification Program Plan;
- **REQUEST** the Board to consider the following elements in a revised Facility Certification Plan and related environmental documents:
 - Strengthen certification standards and requirements for facilities in proximity to sensitive uses such as residential neighborhoods, schools, and parks
 - Establish a role for residents and community based organizations for initial facility certification and during facility inspections and monitoring
