MOTION

Fleet Street is a non-profit corporation that provides vocational training in bicycle maintenance and repair to disadvantaged youth, including those in custody, by rebuilding and refurbishing donated used bicycles. They also provide free bicycle repair stations at community events throughout the City, including Summer Night Lights. They also support community bike rides, including those held in the Third District.

Fleet Street has operated in the San Fernando Valley for a number of years. They are currently seeking a new location and would like to utilize a portion of the parking lot at the West Valley Municipal Building located at 19040 Vanowen Street in Reseda. The parking lot is currently underutilized. They plan to use the location to store materials and conduct bicycle repair/refurbishment workshops for local youth. Their operations would also require a power source in order to use their tools.

ITHEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the Department of General Services (GSD), with assistance of the City Attorney, to negotiate and execute a lease or license agreement with Fleet Street for use of a portion of the parking lot at the City-owned facility located at 19040 Vanowen Street, Reseda, 91335 in consideration of the valuable services that will be provided to the residents of the San Fernando Valley.

I FUTHER MOVE that City Council instruct GSD to report on any costs of the improvements needed in order for Fleet Street to use this location.
