Confirmation that the 11460 Gateway Blvd. SB18-18 Project (Case Number CPC-2015-4086-DB-SPR-CDO/ENV-2015-4087-EAF-VTT-73891) was NOT approved on 2/22/17 regular meeting.

To Whom It May Concern:

This is to confirm that the West LA Sawtelle Neighborhood Council did not approve the 11460 Gateway Blvd. proposed development project as proposed by the developer. The vote was recorded during the general meeting held on 2/22/17.

There was some confusion because the original motion appeared to support the project as proposed.

Please note the following:

- At the January 25, 2017 meeting there were 9 Neighborhood Council members present. The vote for the Gateway Project was 4 Yes. 3 No. 2 Abstain. It was widely reported that this vote meant an approval for the Gateway Project but a representative from the LA City Dept. of Neighborhood Empowerment (Jasmine Elbarbary) who was in attendance at that meeting subsequently reported that the vote was invalid because the WLASNC Bylaws REQUIRE a minimum of 5 'Yes' votes in order to be in compliance. The motion was then resubmitted for a new vote at the following regularly scheduled NC Board meeting on February 22, 2017.
- At the February 22, 2017 NC Board meeting there were 11 Neighborhood Council members present. The same motion was introduced for the Gateway Project as per instructions from the LA City Dept. of Neighborhood Empowerment. A City representative (Semee Park) was in attendance as well as Jasmine Elbarbary. The vote for the Gateway Project was 3 Yes. 7 No. 1 Abstain. The project was NOT approved by the WLASNC.
