PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) Requested Inspection fee.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated May 31, 2018, adding Sections 57.103.7, 57.106.7.1 and 57.106.7.2 to Article 7, Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), establishing a fee for a Requested Inspection; and amending Sections 57.202 and 57.114.1.1 of the LAMC to define a Requested Inspection and establish the method of calculating a fee for a Requested Inspection, respectively.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on August 22, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a City Attorney report and draft Ordinance regarding the LAFD Requested Inspection fee. A representative of the LAFD commented on the current practice of no charge for inspections and how the fees will now provide cost recovery. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
