

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of utilizing Brownfields Program funding for businesses that hope to locate or expand in the Chatsworth-Northridge Industrial Core - innov818 area.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Martinez):

DIRECT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to report on:

- a. The Brownfields Program, including the utilization of this funding source as an option for job-creating businesses that hope to locate or expand in the innov818 zone and may be required to complete environmental investigations, or perform environmental mitigation of toxics or contaminants.
- b. Additional funding options for environmental investigations and mitigations that may be utilized for the innov818 zone.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.


Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a meeting held on November 7, 2017, the Energy, Climate Change and Environmental Justice Committee considered Motion (Englander - Martinez) relative to the feasibility of utilizing Brownfields Program funding for businesses that hope to locate or expand in the Chatsworth-Northridge Industrial Core - innov818 area.
