I strongly encourage you to protect the future of the Hollywood Reporter Building and give it the designation of an Historic-Cultural Monument that it wholeheartedly deserves.

I am a native Angeleno and the Founding Director of a nonprofit organization dedicated to entertainments popular before the invention of cinema - the Velaslavasay Panorama. I am the recent president of the International Panorama Council and a member of the West Adams Heritage Association, the Magic Lantern Society of the United States & Canada and a member of Common Field - a nation-wide network of artist-run nonprofit organizations.

This significant building undoubtedly meets the criteria for HCM designation and should be landmarked.

The "Regency Moderne" style of architecture which the Hollywood Reporter Building represents is known internationally as that which is signature to Los Angeles' cultural heritage. This is a very rare surviving

example - and one which is so connected to the history of Hollywood as a cultural phenomenon. I have personally guided visiting filmmakers, artists and cultural practitioners from as far away as Turkey and the Netherlands to experience the ambiance and history of early 20th Century buildings on Sunset Boulevard.
