

ORDINANCE NO.185540

An ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 179,935, adopted on May 27, 2008, which established the Downtown San Pedro Community Design Overlay (CDO) District.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 179,935, which established the Downtown San Pedro Community Design Overlay (CDO) District in the Los Angeles Municipal Code, is repealed.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


