SAN PEDRO COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE

Council File No.: 17-1044

On June 26, 2018 the update to the San Pedro Community Plan, one of 35 Community Plans that comprise the Land Use Element of the General Plan of the City of Los Angeles became effective. A summary of the actions of the community plan update is as follows:

- Certification of EIR. On October 4, 2017, the City Council certified the Final EIR as found in Council File No. 17-1044 (Exhibit H) for the San Pedro Community Plan Update in compliance with CEQA and Notices of Determination were filed by the Department of City Planning, as required by the Public Resources Code and CEQA Guidelines.
- 2. <u>General Plan Amendments.</u> On October 4, 2017, the City Council adopted the General Plan text and map amendments as found in Council File No. 17-1044 (Exhibit C) to: (a) the San Pedro Community Plan (Land Use Element); and (b) the Mobility Plan 2035 (Circulation Element).
- 3. Implementing Ordinances. On May 15, 2018, the City Council adopted the following three implementing ordinances as found in Council File No. 17-1044: (a) the San Pedro Community Plan Implementation Overlay District (Final Ordinance No. 185539); (b) the repeal of the existing Downtown San Pedro Community Design Overlay District and boundaries (Final Ordinance No. 185540); and (c) the Zone Change and Height District (Final Ordinance No. 185541).
- 4. <u>Effective Date.</u> The General Plan Amendment Resolution Documents (Exhibit C) and the three implementing ordinances (Final Ordinance Nos. 185539, 185540, 185541) are effective as of **June 26, 2018**.
