Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Martinez - Price):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation, in collaboration with the City Administrative Officer (CAO), the Bureau of Engineering, and the Department of Recreation and Parks, to report to the ECCEJ Committee on how to effectively manage green infrastructure assets, on a long-term basis, acquired and built for the purposes of stormwater/water quality improvements; the review should include methods and approaches to explicitly delineate project/site custody, permanent operation and maintenance responsibilities and related matters.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a meeting held on October 17, 2017, the Energy, Climate Change and Environmental Justice Committee considered Motion (Martinez - Price) relative to the progress of the stormwater program, lines of responsibility, compliance with water quality objectives, the transition to operation and maintenance, and related matters. During the discussion of this item, representatives from the Bureau of Sanitation and the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power provided information on this subject and responded to related questions from the Committee members.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendation detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
