Comments for Public Posting: I am in complete favor of this motion to restrict tour bus routes and not allow them on substandard streets. The streets surrounding Lake Hollywood and the Hollywood Sign and surrounding neighborhoods must be included in the list of streets that will be restricted to not allowing tour vans. LADOT should not allow tour buses larger than a minivan of maximum 8 passengers up any streets in the Hills, especially sub standard streets. The tour vans that have inundated our residential area due to the Hollywood Sign attraction rarely obey traffic laws - double parking, making illegal U turns, not stopping smoking by passengers and drivers in high fire severity zones, and stopping intermittently along the road to point out sights with no concern to the traffic behind them, causing congestions and accidents. They do this because there is rarely any enforcement by LAPD in the Hills. Vehicles must have all safety, original equipment such as seat belts, windows and roof, ie. No chop tops. All vehicle should be notified by GPS Mapping/Directional apps that the Hills are a NO SMOKING area throughout LA by color coding the hills in a light red and placing the words NO SMOKING overlaid upon them. Smoking in the hills by tourists have caused at least two fires in the Lake Hollywood area. LAPD, LADOT and RAP Park Rangers should be allowed to enforce the rules for complete enforcement of this motion.
