As a long time resident of Hollywoodland I have observed the blatant disregard of traffic laws and LAMC by a majority of operators. As distracted by guiding tours as drivers on cell phones, lack of attention to the road on the narrow, blind curve hillside roads creates conditions that are overtly dangerous.
