TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to extending the Dockless On-Demand Personal Mobility Device conditional permits for an additional 45 days.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin – Blumenfield):

AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to extend the Dockless On-Demand Personal Mobility Device conditional permits for an additional 45 days from the current expiration date of January 28, 2019 to March 13, 2019.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On January 15, 2019, Council considered Motion (Bonin – Blumenfield) relative to extending the Dockless On-Demand Personal Mobility Device conditional permits for an additional 45 days. Motion states that on September 28, 2018, Council approved a one-year pilot program and authorized LADOT to issue conditional permits that allow interim operation by those companies who meet minimum insurance, indemnification, and safety standards. These conditional permits expire January 28, 2019.

Motion goes on to state that LADOT released the final application for the one-year pilot program on December 24, 2018. The Department will accept applications January 28, 2019, through February 15, 2019. One-year permits will be issued starting March 4, 2019. In order to avoid the expiration of the conditional operating permits before the issuance of the one-year permits, Motion movers recommend the conditional permits be extended up to 45 days. Council referred Motion to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 23, 2019, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendation to extend the Dockless On-Demand Personal Mobility Device conditional permits for an additional 45 days.
