Revised - Approval for the use of a portion of park property under the jurisdiction of the City of Los Angeles, Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) at Dockweiler State Beach for a proposed Subsea Fiber-Optic Cable System connecting the United States and the Asia Pacific Region, also referred to as the Los Angeles Trans-Pacific Telecommunications Cable Hub.

Recommendation for Council Action:

The Board respectfully requests that the City Council review and approve the attached Agreement and revised attachments.

Background:

On February 7, 2018, the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) authorized RAP's General Manager to negotiate an Easement Agreement with Tyco Electronics Subsea Communications, LLC (TE Subcom) (Easement Agreement to follow). The proposed Agreement will connect the United States and the Asia Pacific Region, also referred to as the Los Angeles Trans-Pacific Telecommunications Cable Hub.

The proposed Agreement between the City and Tyco Electron outlines each party's respective roles, responsibilities, and relationship with respect to the design, construction, installation, maintenance, and upgrades of the Los Angeles Trans-Pacific Telecommunications Cable Hub. The term of the proposed Agreement is for twenty-one (21) years and RAP would be compensated the amount of **Five Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$564,000.00)**.

Fiscal Impact Statement:

There is no fiscal impact to RAP's General Fund with the approval of this Agreement. Approving this agreement will have a positive revenue impact to RAP.
